
## ARCHIVE DISPLAY

### SPECIAL ORGAN RECITAL SERIES

In February, Rhys Boak (our resident organist) will present an exciting concert series of 'The Complete Organ Symphonies of Charles-Marie Widor.'

Charles-Marie Widor was born in 1844 into a family of organ builders. Widor seized the multi-movement plan of the orchestral symphony and translated it to the organ. He pushed organ technique to the limit and exhausted the tonal possibilities of the instrument.

Aside from his renowned work as an organist and composer of organ music, Widor published works including music for a variety of chamber ensembles, solo piano, voice, chorus, orchestra symphonies and the theatre. While some of this music is beginning to make a comeback, especially on CD, it is Widor's magnificient organ music that has remained his prominent legacy.

Rhys Boak will be performing this series of Widor's complete organ symphonies, from Monday 6th February to Friday 10th February, at St Michael's Uniting Church from 7.00pm -9.00pm.
