

Revitalisation Project Update

Dear St Michael's Community,

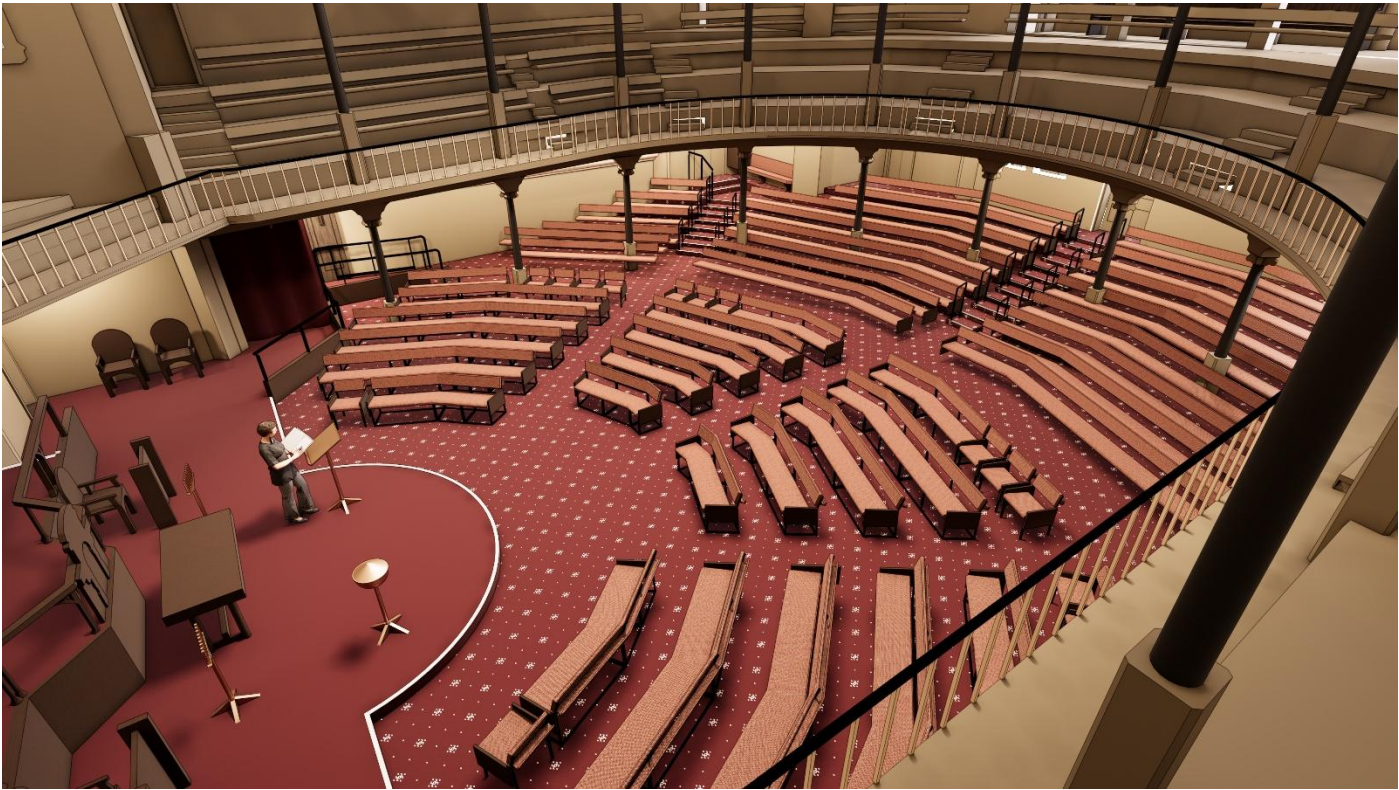
We have seen further progress with the St Michael's Uniting Church Revitalisation Project over the past two weeks.

A timber subfloor structure has been put in place to create a level flooring in the lower auditorium, accessing the church entrances and auditorium seating areas. This will make the entry from St Michael's Walk into the renovated lower auditorium an accessible, welcoming and inclusive space and allow people to move freely within the space.

New glazing has been installed to the east and west cloisters. Enclosing the area means the cloisters can be used all year around, while also providing extra security. The new glass is a minimal intervention that does not detract from the heritage elements.

The project is definitely taking shape and we are well on our way to create an accessible, compassionate and inclusive space.

This week we have some wonderful artist impressions on the church's new look and we are happy to share these images to our community.

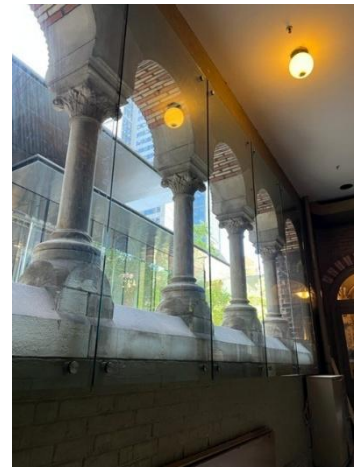
Auditorium
